Your Directors are pleased to present the Management Discussion and Analysis Report for the year ended 31st March, 2019.

The Management Discussion and Analysis have been included in accordance with the Code of Corporate Governance as approved by the Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI). This report has been annexed with the financial statements of the Company to set a background to the workings of the Company. Non-Banking Finance Company (NBFC) Outlook

NBFC's form an integral part of the country's financial structure. They not only compliment the functioning of banks but also facilitate inclusive growth of the economy. The role of NBFCs as effective financial intermediaries has been well recognized as they have inherent ability to take quicker decisions, assume greater risks, and customize their services and charges more according to the needs of the clients. Moreover, NBFCs assume significance in the small business segment as they primarily cater to the credit requirements of the unorganized sector such as wholesale & retail traders, small-scale industries.
